

START TALKING

- What made you want to be so generous or give so abundantly to the other person?



START THINKING

To love lavishly involves bestowing large amounts of love on others. That's how God loved us, even before we came to believe in him. As his followers, God calls us to love others like he loves us.

START DIGGING

Read Romans 5:6-10, Luke 10:25-37, Acts 2:5-12; 36-41, Matthew 22:34-40, 1 John 3:1

- What were you like when you were God's enemy?
- How did God reveal his unconditional love to you?
- What kind of responses do you think the crowd had to the parable of the Good Samaritan?
- On Pentecost people heard about God in their own language (Acts 2:11), what do you think their experience was like?
- What did God call the people to do in response to his message?
- What would the result be if we follow the Law of Moses and love God and our neighbor?



START SHARING

- What would it look like to apply the lesson of the parable of the Good Samaritan in your life?
- How does your daily life compare to the command Jesus us gives in John 13:34-35?
- Consider the neighbors in your life. How can you be a "good samaritan" to them?

START PRAYING

Dear God, thank you for loving me so lavishly and saving me for eternity. Help me obey the law of your kingdom and love others as you have loved me. In Jesus' name. Amen.
