START DIGGING

Read Matthew 28:18-20, 5:13-16, 1 Peter 3:15, John 3:16-18, Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, Romans 5:8, Romans 10:9

- What comes to mind when you think about sharing the Gospel with other people?
- Do you get excited about the opportunity? Is there anything that makes you uncomfortable? Share some of the feelings you may have.
- How have you shared the Gospel with your children or a friend?
- How did it go? Would you change anything?
- According to Peter, as a Christ-follower you should be prepared to share why "you're living the way you are..." Are you prepared? Why or why not?
- Compare the John and Romans verses you just read. How do they work together and compliment each other?
- Why is the admission of sin so important?



START SHARING

- Discuss practical steps that you can take to be ready to share the hope that you have in Christ.
- In this week's teaching video, Rebecca Pippert described a relational style of sharing the Gospel with words of the Gospel, through good deeds, and with the power of the Holy Spirit. What are your thoughts about this method of sharing?
